### Municipal Complex Undergoing Renovations

Work is now ongoing on renovations to the City of Rio Communities Municipal Complex.

One of the big changes to the building will be a transformation of the front facing Highway 47 by using a stucco-stone veneer.

The final product will have two pocket parks, one on either side of the Municipal Complex building.

Landscaping in one of the parks will include a small amphitheater type of structure.

The City Council has hired FBT Architects to coordinate the Municipal Complex renovations plus other improvements in the City of Rio Communities. vide health care information so it was decided to cancel the October health fair.

## Infrastructure Plan Sites Community Needs

The Rio Communities City Council has approved the city's Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan (ICIP) for Fiscal Years 2020-2024.

The top projects for 2020 are:

1. Storm water and drainage plan which would plan and design a complete drainage plan for citywide areas including arroyos, retention ponds, etc. to facilitate future and existing parks/open spaces, trails and roadways.

2. Public safety equipment to purchase and equip new public safety equipment in Rio Communities. This is a six-phase project.

3. Pavement reconstruction.

4. Parks and open space assessment plan which includes purchasing previous park properties.

5. Municipal Complex and Emergency Operations Center which plans, designs, renovates, furnishes and equips the existing Municipal Complex and Emergency Operations Center of Rio Communities.

This multi-phase project renovates the building at 360 Rio Communities Blvd. to accommodate new city offices, a Municipal Court, an Emergency Operations Center and additional spaces for a library, community use and recreation center, law enforcement substation and fire department administrative offices.

6. Roadway beautification which designs and constructs a shoulder along a 1.6 mile section of Highway 47.

Every year the City Council puts together an ICIP for the future which lists projects that could improve life in the City of Rio Communities.

Project funding comes from sources that include legislative appropriations including capital outlay, grants, the city budget, and loans.

Municipalities put together ICIPs so community projects are readily identifiable should funding becomes available.

### Addresses on Buildings for Safety

For everyone's safety, addresses on Rio Communities buildings should be plainly visible and correct. A correct address helps ensure emergency personnel can locate a structure when help is needed.

Numbers should contrast with the background and be a minimum of four-inches high with a minimum stroke width of 1/2 inch.

Consider extra lighting at night to facilitate people locating buildings. The expense could save a life.

### Is Flood Insurance Necessary?

New Mexico summer, and even fall, weather can bring intense heat during the day and incredibly driving rainstorms in the evening (or any other time).

Such rainstorms can cause flooding which brings mud and debris into and onto property.

Home insurance policies do not generally cover such flooding,

Individual home owners should check with their insurance agent on what is covered and what is needed should flooding occur.

#### **Remaining 2018 Cleanup Days**

To help keep Rio Communities clean, the city will have a dumpster in the parking lot of City Hall, 360 Rio Communities Blvd., on Sept. 15, Oct. 20, Nov. 17 and Dec. 15.

## **Road Work To Continue**

Work will continue on various Rio Communities roads thanks to a local government grant the city has received.

Rio Communities will receive \$218,750 which the municipality will match with \$72,917 for a total of \$291,667 to be used for various road repairs including chipping and sealing.
