## ORDINANCE NUMBER 2013-02

### **SECTION 2-1**

#### CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

- **2-1-1 MAYOR**
- **2-1-2 DUTIES**

- 2-1-6 COMPENSATION
- **2-1-1** <u>MAYOR</u>. The chief executive officer of the municipality shall be the Mayor who shall be a qualified elector residing within the limits of the municipality. The Mayor shall be elected for a four (4) year term.
- **2-1-2 <u>DUTIES.</u>** The Mayor shall preside over all meetings of the Council, and shall vote only when there is a tie vote. As the chief executive officer of the municipality, the Mayor shall (a) cause the ordinances and regulations of the municipality to be obeyed; (b) exercise, within the municipality, powers conferred upon sheriffs or counties to suppress disorders and keep the peace; and (c) perform other duties, compatible with the office, which the Governing Body may require, or which may be otherwise required by law.
- **2-1-3** <u>MAYOR PRO TEM</u>, The Council of the municipality shall elect one (1) of its members to serve as Mayor Pro Tem, who in the absence of the Mayor, shall perform the duties of Mayor.
- **2-1-4** <u>VACANCY.</u> In the event of death, disability, resignation or change of residence from the municipality of the Mayor, the Council shall appoint by majority vote a qualified elector to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term of office.
- **2-1-5 BOND AND OATH.** The Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem shall, before they enter the duties of office, if no corporate surety bond covering all municipal officials exist, execute a surety bond to the City or Rio Communities in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) conditioned upon the faithful performance of their duties. The Mayor and Mayor Pro Tern shall take the oath of office as required in Section 14-9-2 N.M.S.A., 1953 Comp.
- **2-1-6** <u>COMPENSATION</u>. The Mayor shall, after having taken the oath of office as required in Section 14-9-2 N.M.S.A., 1953 Comp. Will receive a yearly compensation of O dollars, until compensation is approved by the residents.
