## STATE OF NEW MEXICO CITY OF RIO COMMUNITIES RESOLUTION 2019 - 149

## DISPOSITION OF OBSOLETE, WORN-OUT OR UNUSABLE TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY

- WHEREAS, the Governing Board in and for the City of Rio Communities, State of New Mexico, pursuant to NMSA 1978 Section 3-54-1 (1884) provides that municipalities shall have power at any session to make such orders concerning the property belonging to the municipality as they may deem expedient; and
- WHEREAS, NMSA 1978 Section 3-54-1 (1884) declares that a municipality may dispose of tangible personal property by negotiated sale so long as the property is of a current resale value of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or less and is worn-out, unusable or obsolete to the extent that the item is no longer economical or safe for continued use by the municipality; and
- **WHEREAS,** the official meetings for the review of said documents were duly advertised in compliance with the State Open Meetings Act;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Governing Body of the City of Rio Communities, State of New Mexico:

- Finds that the property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated with this Resolution by reference consists of property owned by the Rio Grande Estates Fire Department; is property of resale value of twentyfive thousand dollars (\$25,000) or less and is worn-out, unusable or obsolete to the extent that the item is no longer economical or safe for continued use by the donor;
- 2. A copy of this shall be sent to the Department of Finance and Administration Local government Division at least thirty days prior to the transfer of the property;
- 3. A copy of this Resolution, Exhibit "A" and the findings of the committee shall be made a permanent part of the official minutes of the municipality and maintained as a public record subject to the Inspection of Public Records Act;
