WHEREAS, the City of Rio Communities adopted its Procurement Policies & Procedures Manual by

passing Resolution 2020-168; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rio Communities Procurement Policies & Procedures Manual was last

updated on March 25, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature adopted the State Procurement Code which shall apply to every

expenditure by local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, except as provided in the state Procurement Code, no local procurement policy may be

inconsistent with the state Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, the state Procurement Code has undergone several amendments since March of 2020

that necessitate changes to the city's procurement policies; and

WHEREAS, whenever the state law changes, so must the local policy; and

WHEREAS, the City would be well-served in adopting the state Procurement Code as it is amended

from time to time as its local procurement code/policy.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RIO COMMUNITIES

THAT: RESOLUTION 2020-158 be and hereby is repealed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The City of Rio Communities adopts the state Procurement Code as it is amended form time-to-time as its procurement process; and
