EMERGENCY RESOLUTION 2025-26

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY 'WITHIN THE CITY OF RIO COMMUNITIES, VALENCIA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO AS A RESULT OF TORRENTIAL DOWN POUR, WATER FOLLOWING DRAINAGE FLOWS FROM MANZANO MOUNTAINS INTO THE CITY OF RIO COMMUNITIES CAUSING DAMAGE AND ENDANGERING CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE INCLUDING ROADS, POWERLINES AND FLOOD CONTROL THAT AFFECTED BOTH PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2025, within the City of Rio Communities there was unexpected torrential downpour and flash flooding by a thunderstorm that started at about 10:00 pm and,

WHEREAS our municipality did receive flooding damage to both public and private properties and,

WHEREAS, the damage has resulted in human suffering and hardship and threatened the safety, health, welfare, and the well-being of the citizens and economic functions of the City of Rio Communities; and,

WHEREAS, all available local, public, and private resources and forces to mitigate and alleviate the damage are deemed insufficient to cope with the resulting situation, initiate repairs, and meet restoration requirements.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: THAT THE GOVERNING BODY HEREBY DECLARES A DISASTER WITHIN CITY OF RIO COMMUNITIES THAT WILL REQUIRE LOCAL AND STATE RESOURCES: Andrew Tabet the Emergency Manager of The City of Rio Communities requesting emergency assistance. By virtue of the power provided in the New Mexico Civil Emergency Preparedness Act (NMSA 1978, 12-10-01 to -11), The City of Rio Communities declares that the City is under a state of Emergency and disaster for the purpose of exercising necessary emergency powers and expenditure of available local resources and for requesting aid, assistance, relief, and funding from the State of New Mexico to mitigate the effects of the disaster.


